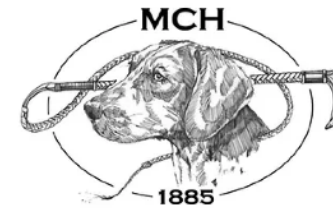

SCHOOLING: DURING THE CLASS, ALL HORSES MUST BE RIDDEN IN OFFICIAL SCHOOLING AREAS. RIDERS MUST WEAR THEIR HORSE'S COMPETITION NUMBER.

ELIGIBILITY: HORSES MUST HAVE COMPLETED THE COURSE IN AT LEAST 2 OVER FENCES CLASSES IN THE CORRESPONDING DIVISION AT THE SAME SHOW. THE FIRST ROUND WILL BE A DESIGNATED CLASS OF EACH DIVISION. HORSES MUST BE ENTERED IN THE DERBY PRIOR TO FIRST ROUND. NO SCRATCHES WILL BE ALLOWED AFTER THE START OF THE FIRST-ROUND CLASS. TOP 12 SCORES RETURN FOR THE SECOND ROUND IN REVERSE ORDER OF SCORE. IN THE CASE OF A TIE AFTER THE FIRST ROUND, ORDER OF THOSE TIED WILL BE DRAWN. IN THE CASE OF AN OVERALL SCORE TIE, THE SECOND-ROUND SCORE WILL SERVE AS THE TIE BREAKER. THE FIRST ROUND WILL BE A DESIGNATED ROUND IN EACH DIVISION. AT THE END OF EACH HORSE'S ROUND, JUDGES WILL GIVE A NUMERICAL SCORE. SCORES WILL BE ADDED TO DETERMINE THE TOTAL FIRST ROUND SCORE. TOP 12 SCORES WILL RETURN FOR THE SECOND ROUND. TIES FOR 12TH BROKEN BY BASE SCORE. **ROUND 2:** THE TOP 12 SCORING HORSES WILL BE INVITED BACK FOR THE HANDY HUNTER ROUND FOLLOWING COMPLETION OF THE QUALIFYING HUNTER DIVISIONS OVER A COURSE OF AT LEAST 8 OBSTACLES SET AT 2'3", 2'6" OR 3'. HANDINESS IS WORKED INTO THE BASE SCORE. A TROT FENCE MAY BE INCLUDED. IN ADDITION, OPTION BONUS SCORE CONSISTING OF ONE ADDITIONAL POINT FOR EVERY HIGHER HEIGHT OPTION JUMPED. 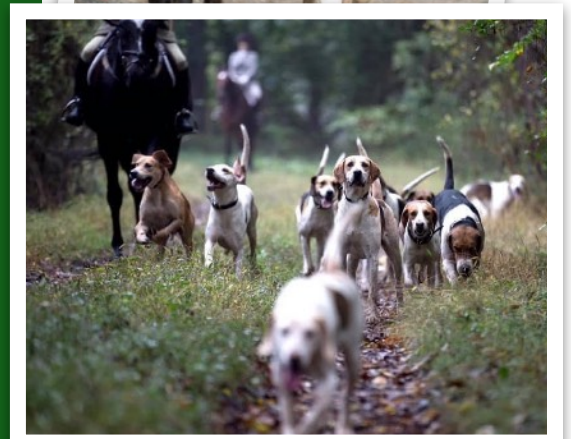

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and _____ ("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors,, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

2. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic we are limiting entries per ring - no refunds will given as each entry will be accounted for.
3. Stalls are not available at this location.
4. There will be a \$ 25.00 charge for horses/ponies schooled but not shown.
5. All horses/ponies must school with a back number.
6. Monmouth County Hunt Inc, Monmouth County Park System, Meg Valnoski, or anyone on the show committee will not be responsible for any accident, loss or damage at the show.
7. Committee reserve the right to cancel/combine move or substitute classes at their discretion.
8. Schooling will be permitted only in areas provided by the committee and scheduled as time permits.
9. Hunter jumper courses may include gates, walls, bushes, oxers, panels and combinations.
10. Footing is stonedust/fiber and sand. 300 x 275 and 200 x 300 @ East Freehold ParkAll warm up areas are sand and fiber footing or stonedust.
11. Hunters will be judged on performance, soundness, and manners.
12. Every class offered is run in accordance with the specs of the current USEF rules.
13. A jump order will be established at the gate with the starter.

15. All pets must be kept on a leash.
16. Sharps containers will be located at the show office .
17. All entries not paid at the horse show will incur a \$ 50.00 late payment fee.
18. A \$25.00 fee will be charged to all entries for office fee and a \$10.00 grounds and EMT fee.
19. For all sanctioned classes other than USEF pointed classes such as WIHS/THIS/Ariat/M&S, horse and rider combination must enter at least one other class at that same show.
20. All prize money will be issued at the show. No scratches permitted.
21. **WARNING:** under the NJ state law, an equestrian area operator is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine animal activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine animal activities, pursuant to p.l.,1997, c 287
22. **USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE STATEMENT:** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/ legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. 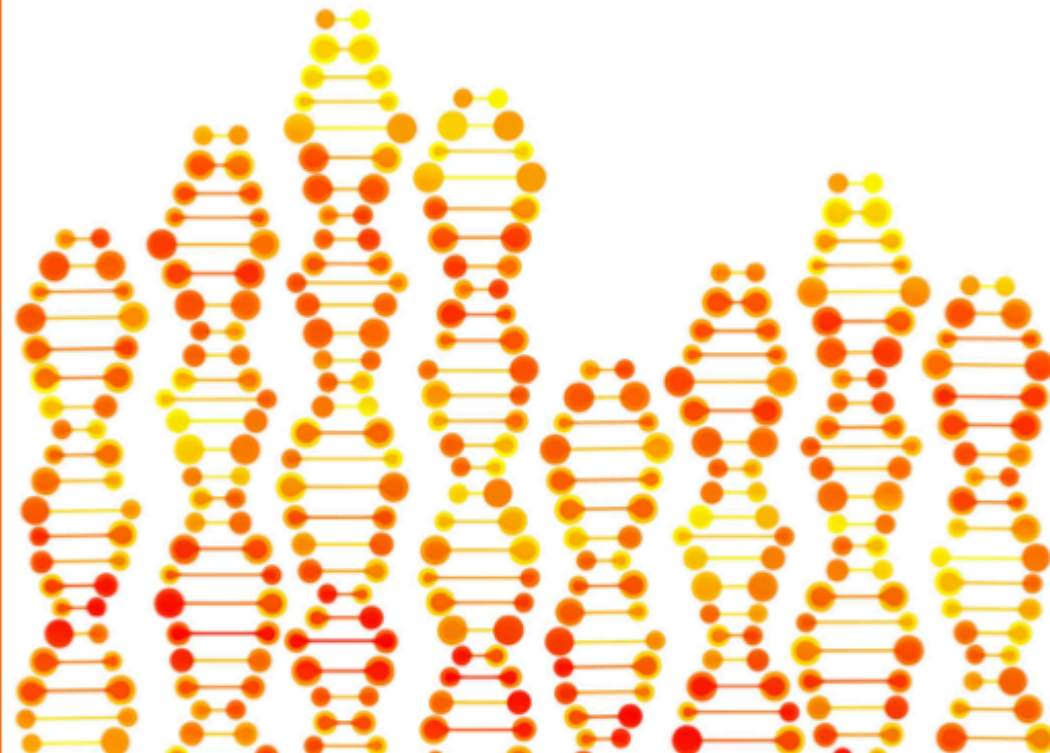
